ADDITIONAL DETAILS ON FAITH DAY

This year, choirs and singing ensembles from across the region will have the chance to perform on the field at Nationals Park during the Faith Day program. The church that has the highest Faith Day attendance will be invited to sing the national anthem prior to the game, while the four churches that bring out the next most fans will be invited to perform on the field following the game—in between player testimonials. If your congregation is on the smaller side, you still have a chance to perform as all churches in attendance will be entered into a drawing to perform for the fifth postgame performance slot. Faith Day is free with the purchase of any ticket to the Nationals vs. Marlins game that day. To help make this event as accessible as possible, the Nationals have established group ticket discounts, with some tickets as low as \$12. You can buy these discounted tickets [at www.nationals.com/faith](http://www.nationals.com/faith). A \$5 donation to The House DC (thehousedc.org) will be set aside from every ticket sold. The House DC is a Southeast DC-based 501(c)(3) that aims to transform and empower the lives of inner city youth and their families through Jesus, by giving them hope, a productive future, and a changed community. We will select choir performers based on the number of tickets purchased directly through this link (or from a Nationals ticket sales representative).

Faith Day will start approximately 15-20 minutes after the conclusion of the game and last for about an hour.

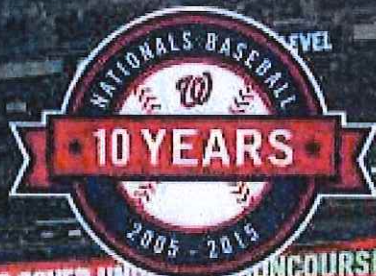

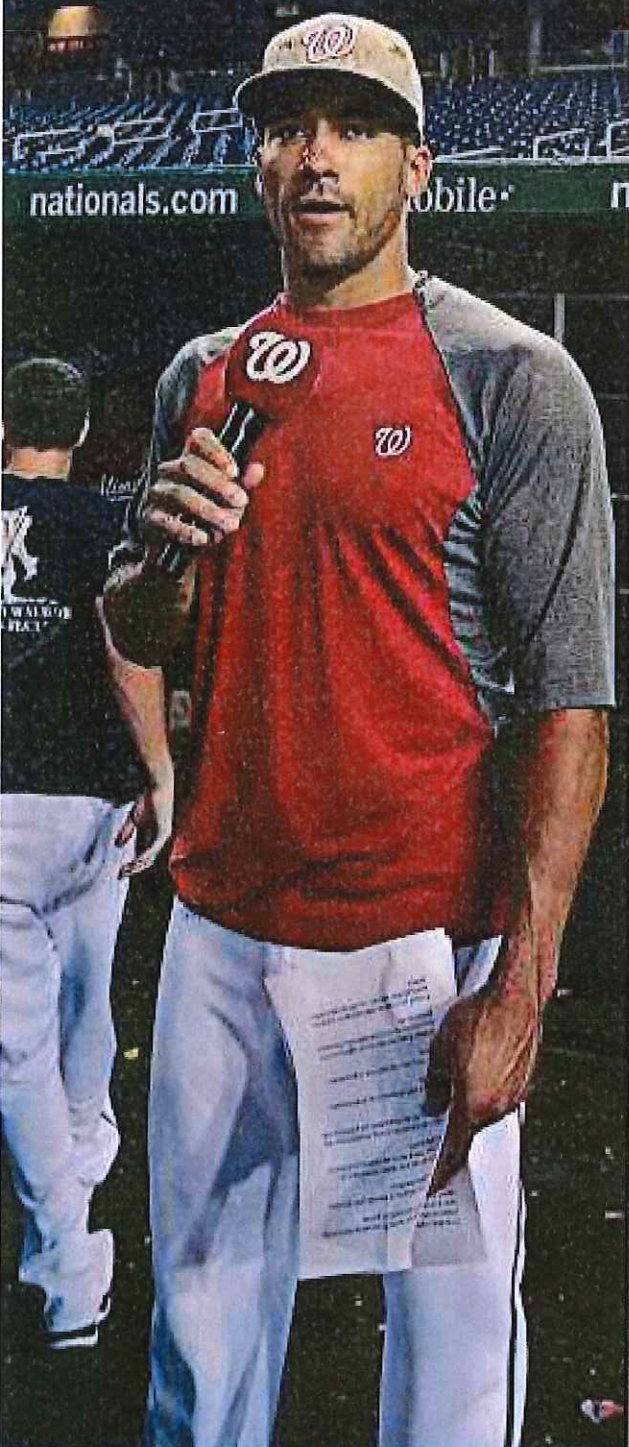
