

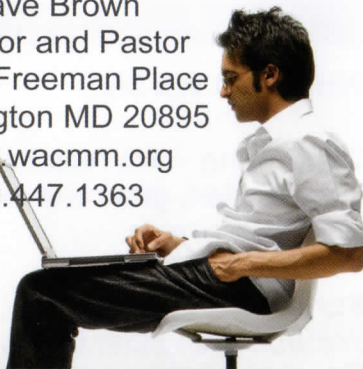

Conferences – Our premiere regional and national men's gatherings have attracted over 40,000 men

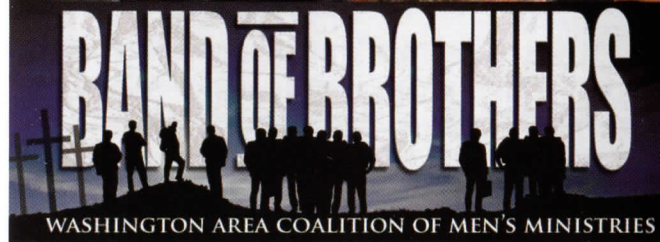
Speaking – Our Speakers Bureau has some of the best men's speakers in the country for conferences, retreats, breakfasts, seminars and other kinds of events

WHAT WE BELIEVE ABOUT MANHOOD

The Bible teaches that men are foundational. As go the men, so go marriages, families, churches, communities and the culture.
